Tips and Tricks

In this issue we look at the important factors involved in the cleaning process

- The size and design of the ultrasonic cleaner
- Always use a holding rack or basket
- Instruments or parts need to be easily accommodated by the holding rack or basket
- Holding devices should never be overloaded giving rise to inefficiency
- The cleaning fluid that will remove contamination in a rinse or soak is a good indicator for the cleaning solution
- Compatibility of the base material on the parts immersed
- Heated solution will always expedite the cleaning duration
- Pre rinse on parts with heavily deposited residue maybe necessary
- Turnover of dirty liquid periodically
- Always rinse off soapy residue in clean water
